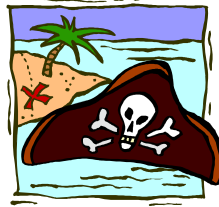


Youth Programs

Youth Spanish Lessons

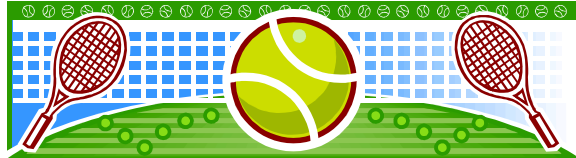
