Dear Current Transportation Rider:

It is that time of year, to renew your current Canton Transportation “Ridership” for the Fiscal Year 2017/18 to be effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. The suggested donation for all Services remains the same this year, at \$50.00 for an entire year per individual and reduced rates for lower income riders [\$35.00].

The annual income limits for reduced fee eligibility are:

- Single Person less than \$22,249/yr. (\$1,872/month total)
- Couple less than \$31,451/yr. (\$2,538/month total)

Regular Dial-A-Ride service area and hours of operation (including rotating summer weekend days of service) will remain the same; dispatching/call-in hours for reservations being taken until 12noon daily (remember to call by Thursday for weekend travel!).

Enhanced Medical Transportation services will continue to be administered using the same policies and procedures as before, and all transportation services will be provided again through Martel Transportation LLC of Canton.

To continue using Transportation Services through the town of Canton without interruption for the upcoming fiscal year we need you to complete and mail the enclosed application. **ALL RIDERS must complete an application, which enables you to use ALL [regular Dial-A-Ride as well as enhanced Medical] Transportation services.**

You may send in your donation check, for the appropriate amount made payable to the **“Town of Canton”** with your application (preferred) or when you are able.
