

Town of Canton
November 8, 2016 State Election

The Electors of the Town of Canton are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, for the following purposes:

I. To cast their votes for Presidential and Vice-Presidential electors, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative and Registrar of Voters.

II. To vote on the following local question for approval or disapproval of a resolution approved by the Board of Selectmen on August 31, 2016, which question will be placed on the voting machines under the following heading:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF CANTON APPROPRIATE \$3,825,000 FOR DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPPING OF A NEW CANTON PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY TO BE LOCATED ON THE SITE OF THE CURRENT FACILITY AT 50 OLD RIVER ROAD IN CANTON; AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS AND NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

The vote on the above question will be taken under the authority of Sections 7-7, 9-369 and 9-369d of the Connecticut General Statutes. A vote of “YES” will be a vote for approval of the resolution, and a vote of “NO” will be a vote for disapproval of said resolution. The full text of the resolution is on file and open to public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk. Application for absentee ballots should be made to the Town Clerk’s office. Electors shall vote on the question at their polling place. Persons qualified to vote in town meetings who are not electors shall vote on the question at the following polling place: Room #208, Canton High School, 76 Simonds Avenue, Canton, Connecticut.

Notice is hereby given that the location of the polling place is as follows: Canton High School, 76 Simonds Ave, Canton, CT

Voting machines will be used. The polls will be opened at six o'clock in the morning (6:00 a.m.) and will remain open until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.).
