User Fees:

Annual Permit Vehicle Stickers may be purchased by Canton residents on a pro rata basis as follows:

Between January 1 and March 31 \$175.00 Between April 1 and June 30 \$130.00 Between July 1 and September 30 \$85.00 Between September 1 and December 31 \$40.00

- Unlimited trips, January 1, 2026 December 31, 2026
- Everyday household trash, food waste, all recycling, Swap-Shack usage
- Must present vehicle registration upon purchase
- Additional stickers for vehicles registered to the same person/address \$5
- Qualifying Town of Canton Volunteer Fire & EMS personnel pursuant to the Town of Canton Board of Selectman resolution on 10/26/2022 will receive a free annual permit.

One-Day Use Pass – \$15 (multiple trips, same day)

- Everyday household trash, food waste, all recycling, Swap-Shack usage
- Must present proof of residency upon purchase

Bulky Waste – Annual Permit or One-Day Use Pass required, plus an additional fee based on the size of the load. Please note: *some items have a specific fee*. See the Bulky Waste payment schedule for details.

- Tokens, which are purchased in \$5 increments as proof of payment, are turned-in to the Transfer Station
 Attendant when dropping off Bulky Waste. Tokens can be purchased in any quantity, do not expire, and are nonrefundable.
- Bulky Waste is: Oversized items that would not be considered regular "kitchen trash" or recycling (rugs, furniture, private household construction debris, etc.)
- PLEASE NOTE: Bulky Waste tokens and One-Day Use Passes may be purchased <u>directly at the Transfer Station</u> using a Credit Card or Personal Check

FREE for Canton residents - No permit or fees / Proof of residency IS required

BULKY WASTE FEE SCHEDULE

a) Once a resident is permitted, there will be a fee charged based on the vehicle type at the time of each bulky waste drop-off, load size will be determined by transfer station attendant. The schedule of type of vehicle and fees is as follows:

Type of Vehicle	Disp	oosal Fee

Mini Van, Pick-up and/or 8 Foot Trailer	½ load	\$20
Mini Van, Pick-up and/or 8 Foot Trailer	full load	\$40
Greater than 8 Foot Trailer and/or Dump Truck	½ load	\$60
Greater than 8 Foot Trailer and/or Dump Truck	full load	\$120

b) There will be a charge for individual items as follows:

Unacceptable Mattresses or Box Springs	\$40 each
Regular Tires	\$10 each
Truck Tires	\$20 each

c) There will be a charge for brush/logs:

Type of Vehicle	Brush Disposal Fee	Logs Disposal Fee
Car	\$15	\$20
Mini Van, Pick-up and/or 8 Foot Trailer	\$30	\$40
Greater than 8 Foot Trailer and/or Dump Truck	\$60	\$80
