2026 Schedule of Town Budget Meetings

Town boards and leadership are already hard at work developing the 2026-2027 town budget for Canton. Our volunteers and staff are committed to developing a budget that meets the needs and preferences of our residents. To help the town develop a fiscal budget that will pass the first time, it is important to have our residents participate early in the process. The purpose of this flyer is to inform you about the budget meetings held during the winter and invite you to attend. Ideas and suggestions from the public are welcome as we shape our town budget. We all are residents and we all pay taxes; please be a part of the process. And then, in May, please VOTE in the budget referendum. Make sure your voice is heard.

All meetings are open to the public, and most are available virtually. Minutes and recordings of the meetings are posted on the town website within a week after a meeting was held. All residents are encouraged to be informed, involved, and participate in the budget process.
