Native Range: Temperate Regions of North America

Height: 40 to 60 feet

Spread: 35 to 40 feet

Bloom Description: Yellowish Green, Orange/Red in Fall

Sun: Full Sun, Partial Shade

Water: Average

Maintenance: Low

Suggested Use: Specimen in Parks and Gardens

Fruit: Two Winged Samara

Tolerate: Acidic, Well Drained Soils
