What Is The Program?

The Good Morning Canton program is a voluntary service which provides a safety and security net for town residents and their families. The program was created for seniors who live alone and don't have regular daily communication with friends or family members. The program provides participants the security in knowing that someone will be able to check on them in the event that they have a medical or other emergency and are not able to call for help. The program is facilitated by the Canton Police Department through our 911 Dispatchers and Police Officers.

How The Program Works

The Good Morning Canton program begins with applicants filling out an enrollment form and providing critical information to the police department ahead of time. Once enrolled, the participants place a call directly to the police department each morning between 6AM and 10AM. If the on duty police dispatcher does not receive a call from the participant by 10AM, phone calls will be made directly to them. If contact with the participant is unable to be achieved by phone, a police officer will be sent to the home. If that police officer is unable to make contact with the participant and no family members or key holders can be reached, then the officer may force entry into the home.

Program Advice

The program is completely voluntary and the Canton Police Department reserves the right to discontinue the service at any time. It is strongly recommended that participants install a lock box with a house key on the exterior of the residence. Participants should provide the lock box combination and lock box location to the police department ahead of time to eliminate any damage in the event that forced entry is required into the residence. Forced entry into a residence is always a last resort but may be required in the event of true emergency.
