These courses are FREE to residents of Farmington, Unionville, Avon, Canton, Collinsville, Burlington, and Harwinton. Registration is required for ALL courses!

# GED

Adults who have not completed high school must demonstrate attainment of academic skills and concepts normally acquired through completion of a high school program.

# CREDIT DIPLOMA PROGRAM (CDP)

For motivated, independent learners with a busy work schedule who have 4-7 credits left to earn a diploma. Made up of a combination of teacher-led courses and an internet-based high school curriculum. Earn credits through independent study projects, community service, work experience, or vocational training.
