Description of program: \_\_\_\_\_

Our program would involve upgrading of existing fluorescent lighting to LED lighting at two locations of Favarh programs at 15 Canton Springs Road and 225 Commerce Drive in Canton. This upgrade would improve working conditions, reduce costs and promote energy conservation.

Need for program: \_\_\_\_\_

LED lighting is much more efficient than fluorescent. According to the U.S. Department of Energy LED's use 20% less power making their use much more energy efficient. Fluorescent bulbs are also omnidirectional while LED's are directional using all projected lighting. Fluorescent bulbs also emit UV light which can be very hard on the eyes and causes color fading in fabric. In conserving costs LED lights last longer than fluorescent bulbs, up to 13 times longer. Exposure to mercury in fluorescent lights is also a problem. Fluorescent lights also flicker before burning out, again limiting usefulness. The upgrade will improve working conditions for all, conserve energy and reduce overall expenses.
